

## Dhawan, Ellis dazzle in Punjab's thrilling win

**GUWAHATI:** Shikhar Dhawan (86 off 56 balls) and Nathan Ellis (4/30) displayed an all round excellent performance as Punjab Kings beat Rajasthan Royals by 5 runs in Guwahati on Wednesday.

Shikhar Dhawan played a captain's knock, and was well supported by Prabhsimran Singh who blazed to 60 off 34 balls, as Punjab Kings set a total of 197 runs off their stipulated 20 overs.

While it was the first home match for Rajasthan Royals in IPL 2023 at their adopted home- the Barsapara Cricket Stadium in Guwahati, Punjab Kings had the last laugh at this venue. The 2014 IPL finalists beat the inaugural champions and last year runners up by 5 runs in match number 8 of the 2023 edition of the tournament.

Even though Punjab did not win the toss, they dominated much of the contest with captain Shikhar Dhawan leading from the front with his unbeaten record-breaking 86. His innings along with Prabhsimran Singh's quickfire 60 off 34 balls laid the foundation of what eventually turned out to be a match-winning 197/4.

**KOLKATA:** After a loss against Punjab Kings in their IPL-2023 opener, Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) will look to get their combination right to earn their first win when they take on Royal Challengers Bangalore at the Eden Gardens today (Thursday).

With Shreyas Iyer out with injury, the Kolkata-based team's combination suffered a body blow and the team management will have a lot of homework to do to get past an in-form RCB side, who got off to a flying start after beating Mumbai Indians on Sunday.

Shakib Al Hasan pulling out of IPL season will also come as a big headache for Chandrakanth Pandit-coached side.

But keeping all these aside, the team will aim to bring forward their best game to bag their first win of the season and that too at their own. The team had a good outing against Punjab but the match was eventually decided on DLS method after rain stopped play. In the batting department, opener Rahmanullah Gurbaz, Venkatesh Iyer looked in fine tough along with skipper Nitish Rana.

All-rounder Andre Russell also joined the party with some big hits but failed to take his team over the line. The batters getting runs under their belt will surely boost their confidence but they need to step up as a team to hand KKR their first win.

## KKR signs Jason Roy

**KOLKATA:** Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) have signed England's Jason Roy for Rs 2.8 crore for 2023 IPL from his base price of Rs 1.5 crore.

Shreyas Iyer has been ruled out of the tournament owing to a lower back injury, while Bangladesh all-rounder Shakib Al Hasan has confirmed his unavailability for the season, KKR confirmed.

Roy, who earlier featured in the 2017 and 2018 seasons, last played in the 2021 season for Sunrisers Hyderabad. In 2021, he played five games, scoring 150 runs including a half-century. The 32-year-old has played 64 T20s for England, scoring 1522 runs at a S/R of 137.61 with 8 fifties.

## International Rollball tournament to be held in Pune

## Chelsea, Liverpool draw a blank

**LONDON:** Chelsea's first game since Graham Potter's sacking on Sunday failed to see any magic solution to the club's problems as they drew 0-0 at home to Liverpool.

Interim coach Bruno Salto saw his side miss several good chances, while Reece James and Kai Havertz both had goals disallowed in a result that leaves Liverpool eighth in the table and Chelsea 11th, with both struggling to qualify for Europe next season. Brighton gave their chances of European football a big boost with a 2-0 win away to relegation threatened Bournemouth. Young striker Ewan Ferguson put the visitors ahead after 27 minutes.

## SPN India extends its broadcast partnership with SL cricket

**MUMBAI:** Sony Pictures Networks India (SPN) has extended its exclusive global media rights to broadcast Sri Lanka Cricket matches for the next four years until March 2027. With this deal, starting April 2023, the broadcaster can exclusively televise and livestream globally, the senior men's cricket matches hosted by SLC during the term of the agreement except Sri Lanka where the broadcaster has only pay television rights.

The next five years will be exciting for cricket fans, as team Sri Lanka will take on the likes of India, Australia, England, New Zealand, Pakistan, South Africa, West Indies, Ireland, and Afghanistan on their home turf. Starting on April 16, 2023, the broadcaster will showcase matches of The Lions, who will take on Ireland in a two-match Test series. Sri Lanka will then move on to finish an exhilarating summer of cricket by hosting arch-rivals Pakistan in July 2023, where they will look to leverage their home advantage.

The Men in Blue will prepare to take on Sri Lanka on their home turf in 2024 and 2026. After a two-year hiatus, Team India will play 3 ODIs and 3 T20Is against Sri Lanka in July 2024. Team India will return to Sri Lanka in August 2026 to play their first Test series (2 matches) in the country since 2017.

With the extension of the partnership with Sri Lanka Cricket, SPN will now have the broadcast rights of England and Wales Cricket Board and Pakistan Cricket Board. The current Asian cricket champion, Sri Lanka, is a formidable team in the continent and the extended partnership with Sri Lanka Cricket will engage cricket fans across markets. We will continue our momentum to serve cricket fans with quality international cricket."

## Osasuna qualify for Copa del Rey final

**MADRID:** Osasuna booked a place in the Copa del Rey final on Tuesday night after Pablo Ibanez's goal in the 115th minute gave them a 1-1 draw away to Athletic Bilbao and a 2-1 aggregate win.

Ibanez placed a volley into the corner of the net to put his side through after Osasuna were kept in the tie by a string of fine saves from keeper Sergio Herrera.

Herrera made five or six vital saves as Athletic attacked, but once again paid for their inability to find the net. The home side started looking to get quickly back onto level terms in the tie, with Gorka Guruzeta seeing his effort

well smothered by Osasuna keeper Sergio Herrera in the seventh minute. The game was as intense as you would expect in the return leg of a semifinal between the local rivals and Athletic midfielder Mikel Vesga was the first player booked after a challenge from behind.

Oihan Sancet, looking to celebrate his new contract with Athletic, got into good positions on the edge of the Osasuna area on a couple of occasions, but nobody was able to get onto his pull backs. Nico Williams fired wide as Athletic continued to press and Herrera did well to parry Oscar de Marcos' diving header after a good cross from the young winger.

## Freiburg beat Bayern, progress into German Cup semis

**BERLIN:** Lucas Holer's late handball penalty helped Freiburg to upset record champions Bayern Munich with a 2-1 comeback win in the quarterfinals on Tuesday. Freiburg staged a well-positioned defense from the outset and was able to keep the hosts at bay in the opening stages. Despite not creating clear-cut opportunities, Bayern still opened the scoring with 20 minutes gone as Dayot Upamecano headed home a corner kick from Joshua Kimmich.

The visitors maintained their shape and restored parity only seven minutes later through Nicolas Hofer, who collected a clearance from Kingsley Coman before drilling the ball from 16 meters past Bayern goalkeeper Yann Sommer.

Bayern responded with furious attacks before halftime, but neither Leon Goretzka nor Thomas Muller was able to overcome Freiburg custodian Mark Flekken despite promising chances. After the restart,

Bayern dominated possession and pressed Freiburg onto the back foot but couldn't do any damage in the opening stages.

Just when the spectators settled for the extra time, Hofer collected a loose ball at the edge of the box and hit Jamal Musiala, who deflected the hammer with his elbow to cause a penalty. Hofer stepped up and converted the penalty into the roof of the net in injury time. "I am delighted that we have clinched a win. We had the luck we needed and defended very well. It was a one-sided affair in the second half, but we defended passionately and got the penalty to win the game," said Freiburg coach Christian Streich. "I am not disappointed as we conceded two goals from two long-range efforts. We had some good stages, but we failed to maintain the momentum. We lacked in accuracy in the final third. It is sad because it is our own fault as we lost on home soil in a quarterfinal," said Bayern coach Thomas Tuchel.

## Govt declares plan to add 50 GW renewable energy annually

**NEWDELHI:** The government on Wednesday said that it has decided to invite bids for 50 GW of renewable energy capacity annually for the next five years. The annual bids of ISTS (Inter-State Transmission) connected renewable energy capacity will also include setting up of wind power capacity of at least 10 GW per annum, an official statement said.

The plan was finalized by Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) at a meeting chaired by Union Minister for Power & NRE R K Singh last week. India currently has a total renewable energy capacity of 168.96 GW (as on 28th February 2023) with about 82 GW at various stages of implementation and about 41 GW under tendering stage.

This includes 64.38 GW Solar

Power, 51.79 GW Hydro Power, 42.02 GW Wind Power and 10.77 GW Bio Power.

Considering the fact that Renewable Energy (RE) projects take around 18-24 months for commissioning, the bid plan will add 250 GW of renewable energy and ensure 500 GW of installed capacity by 2030, the statement said. "Declaration of trajectory of short-term and long-term RE capacity addition by the Government is a significant step towards achieving the goal of 500 GW of non-fossil fuel capacity by 2030 and towards a faster energy transition," Union Minister for Power & NRE R K Singh said.

"India has emerged as one of the world leaders in Energy Transition and this is evident in the growth that we have achieved in the area of Renewable Energy.

## Nitin Agarwal appeal from govt to reduce GST

**PUNE:** Leading businessman and Director of Vijaylaxmi Steel group Pune Nitin Agarwal has appealed from government of India to reduce GST on scrap by 12 percent.

Agarwal said that GST on Scrap are 18 percent presently which should reduce to 12 percent. He also demanded that government should give subsidy on electricity to Steel manufacturers since steel plants consumed more power. Agrawal written letter to government of India requesting to allow to digging more coal Mines in the country so that coals can be available easily to all and import of it be avoided.

Elaborating further on GST, Agarwal said that total collection on gst for the last financial year (2022-23) stands at rupees 18.10 lakh crore.

The one lakh sixty thousand crores GST revenue was collected in the month of March itself, if the government consider to reduce GST by 12 percent, the collection of government can become double from present status, opined Agarwal.

Looking into welfare for Steel owners of the country, Agarwal appeal from Govt to consider his demand on GST because India is the one of the 3rd largest Steel consumption in the world, he added.

## Beware of fake customer care centers

**NEW DELHI:** As a rule the contact numbers of Customer care centers should only be taken from the website of the concerned department or institution rather than a random Google search as internet searches could throw up fraud numbers.

Retired Delhi University Professor. Rita Brara was duped of Rs 29,997 by one such fake customer care center "I needed to retrieve my PNB demat number which I had lost, I was frantically calling up the Customer Care number but no one was answering, so out of desperation I Googled if they have some other Customer Care number.

I got one such number in the search result and called it, it sounded exactly like a customer care as the person answering the call interacted with me in exactly the same manner in which a CC executive attends a complaint.

## Ossus Biorenewables raises USD 2.4 mn

**MUMBAI:** Green energy start-up Ossus Biorenewables, on Wednesday said it has raised USD 2.4 million in a pre-Series A round from Gruhas and Rainmatter Climate.
